



NEW HSE GUIDANCE ON COMPACTION EQUIPMENT: USER AND PUBLIC SAFETY

The Health and Safety Executive (HSE), in consultation with, and the support of, the Waste Industry Safety and Health Forum (WISH), has now published a 'best practice' guide for user and public safety in relation to the use of Compaction equipment.

This guidance is for site managers, supervisors and operators of Compaction equipment including premises where balers/ compactors (packer units) are used to process materials from a number of different sources. The document focuses on public safety and risks to operators.

The HSE advises that reference to this guidance may help industry dutyholders to devise, institute, monitor and revise methods of work on their sites.
