



CONSULTATION BY THE INSTITUTE OF DIRECTORS: NEW GUIDANCE ON DIRECTORS' RESPONSIBILITIES FOR HEALTH AND SAFETY

IoD is conducting the consultation on the draft version of the guidance and is keen to hear your views; the consultation runs for a 6 week period until approximately 22 June.
