### **ANNUAL CONFERENCE- OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH AND SAFETY IN THE FOOD INDUSTRY**

**10<sup>TH</sup> - 11<sup>TH</sup> OCTOBER 2007**

Following on from the success of the October 2006 and earlier conferences, the joint HSE/ Food Industry conference in 2007 will take place on the 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> October 2007. The conference will be held at Campden & Chorleywood Food Research Association, Chipping Campden, Gloucestershire.

The conference programme will cover important and topical issues such as upper limb disorders (ULD's), work-related stress, rehabilitation and worker involvement, leadership and participation in Health and Safety with break out sessions on back injury prevention, flour dust and respiratory risks, dermatitis, prevention of slips, work equipment and thermal environment.
